

## **Marriages by Licence of Thanet People 1724 & 1734 Diocese of Canterbury Bonds & Allegations**

---

### **Scope**

Details from Marriages Licences with at least one of the parties resident in Thanet, gleaned from original material published on Kent FHS microfiche :

- 1724 Canterbury Diocesan Bonds & Allegations ~ published on KFHS microfiche 1011
- 1734 Canterbury Diocesan Bonds ~ published on KFHS microfiche 1033
- 1734 Canterbury Diocesan Allegations ~ published on KFHS microfiche 1034

This document includes details not found in Cowper's Canterbury Marriage Licences Fifth & Sixth Series ~ ie. occupations, ages, alternative surname spellings, bondsmen and a few references to parents.

### **Arrangement**

Entries are arranged alphabetically, by surname of the intended groom. In order, an entry includes his details; those of the intended bride; those of the person giving bond; the parish church(es) in which the marriage is licensed to take place; the date that the licence was obtained (as in the original record with none converted to 'new style'); and a reference to the original record.

The names of Thanet's parishes have been simplified to exclude trivial spelling variants, etc, and are not suffixed with 'in Thanet'. The parishes are : Birchington, Minster, Monkton, Sarre, St John, St Lawrence, St Nicholas and St Peter ~ there are no conflicts with Minster in Sheppey, etc.

Entries are numbered, and these are used in the Persons, Places and Occupations & Ranks Indexes starting on page 4. The Persons index groups together all surname variants, and the names of the intended brides, persons giving bond, and parents.
